(5.4) Literature

I <u>CAN</u> determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, including figurative language such as metaphors and similes.

(5.4) Informational

I <u>CAN</u> demonstrate my knowledge of grade level content vocabulary words.

I <u>CAN</u> explain how a series of chapters, scenes, or stanzas fits together to provide the **overall** structure of a story, drama, or poem.
