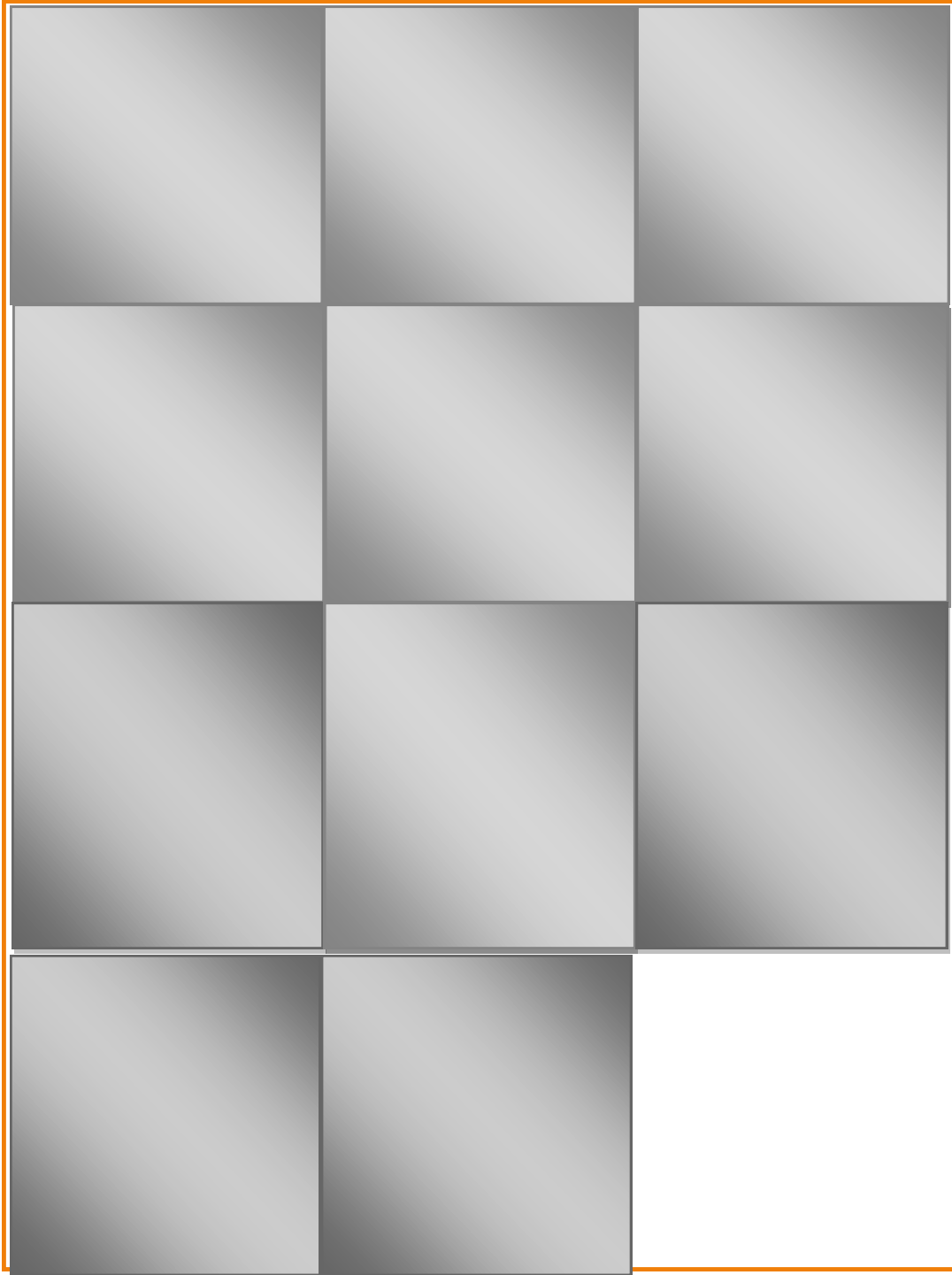


Connect the Dots

Connect the Dots is meant to be used with pictures, maps, photographs, & other visual representations that hold meaning in piece.

Students place the sheet over their visual piece, and try to “connect the dots” between the small glimpses that they have of the piece, in order to develop their questioning skills.

This is especially useful when used with a double-entry journal in which to record questions about the pieces that they think they see.

When the students read the text connected to the visual , they should use their think sheet to confirm or revise their prediction (using text evidence).
